

Phonetic Add-A-Letter Six

Fill in the three spaces after number 1 with the three-letter phonetic spelling of the answer to clue 1. Then rearrange these three phonetic letters and add a fourth phonetic letter to them somewhere to form the four-letter phonetic spelling of the answer to clue 2. (Write the fourth letter you added in the space after the + sign.) Then rearrange the four letters of this phonetic spelling and add a fifth phonetic letter to form a five-letter phonetic spelling to the answer to clue 3. (Write the fifth letter you added in the space after the + sign.) Repeat these three steps with the three, four, and five-letter phonetic spellings to the answers to clues 4-6, 7-9, and 10-12. When completed, the phonetic letters after the + signs will form, reading down (↓), the phonetic spellings of the answers to clues 13 and 14.
